Dr. Nicol C. Rae (D. Phil, Oxford University) is Professor of Political Sciences and Senior Associate Dean of the College of Arts & Sciences at Florida International University, Miami, Florida. His most recent book (coedited with Timothy Power) is *Exporting Congress: The Influence of the US Congress on World Legislatures* (Pittsburgh: University of Pittsburgh Press, forthcoming). Other books include *Impeaching Clinton: Partisan Strife on Capitol Hill* (with Colton Campbell); and *Conservative Reformers: The Republican Freshmen and the Lessons of the 104th Congress.* Professor Rae has also written numerous journal articles and book chapters on American and European politics and government.
