**Dr. Nicol C. Rae** (D. Phil, Oxford University) is Professor of Political Science and Senior Associate Dean of the College of Arts & Sciences at Florida International University, Miami, Florida. His most recent book (co-edited with Timothy Power) is *Exporting Congress: The Influence of the US Congress on World Legislatures* (Pittsburgh: University of Pittsburgh Press, forthcoming). Other books include *Impeaching Clinton: Partisan Strife on Capitol Hill* (with Colton Campbell); and *Conservative Reformers: The Republican Freshmen and the Lessons of the 104th Congress*. Professor Rae has also written numerous journal articles and book chapters on American and European politics and government. He was chosen for an *American Political Science Association Congressional Fellowship* in 1995-1996, and was *Gwyllim Gibbon Prize Research Fellow* at Nuffield College Oxford from 1985-1988.
