

#### Japanese Studies Students

- \*At least 18 and under 30 years of age
- \*Undergraduate at a non-Japanese university majoring in a field related to the Japanese language or culture at the time of arriving in and leaving Japan

\*Note: in principle, applicants must have studied at a non-Japanese university for at least one year to be eligible

#### **Teacher Training Students**

- \*Under 35 and graduate of a collage or teacher training collage.
- \* You must have at least five years of active experience as a teacher in your country.
