Václav Klaus has been a major figure in Czech and European politics since the end of the Cold War. He was trained as an economist and served as Professor of Finance at the University of Economics in Prague; Minister of Finance and Vice Chairman of the government for the Czechoslovak Federal Republic; Prime Minister of the Czech Republic; Chairman of the Chamber of Deputies in the Czech parliament; and is serving his second term as President of the Czech Republic. He has published over 20 books on social, political and economic themes.
