Dr. Jerry Brown, Founding Professor of Global and Sociocultural Studies at Florida International University in Miami, has been researching and writing on nuclear power and energy issues since 1979, the year of the Three Mile Island accident. His 2007 book, *Freedom from Mid-East Oil*, includes a chapter on "Nuclear Power: A Mistake in Search of a Mission" which summarizes the economic, safety, health and national security risks of nuclear power. His earlier work, *Profiles in Power: The Antinuclear Movement and the Dawn of the Solar Age*, summarizes world-famous radiation expert, Dr. John W. Gofman's, prediction of nearly 1,000,000 long-term cancer deaths worldwide from the 1986 Chernobyl accident.
