26th Anniversary of Germany's Reunification Lecture by the Honorable Jürgen Borsch Consul General of Germany

This year marks the 25th anniversary of Germany's reunification. On October 3, 1990, East Germany and West Germany reunited to form a single nation. This historic decision marked the end of the unification process, which began with the fall of the Berlin Wall on November 9, 1989.



Consul General Jürgen Borsch has had extensive international experiences representing the Federal Republic of Germany in key overseas positions in Warsaw, Damascus, Washington D.C., and Hong Kong. Prior to his assignment in Miami he was Director of the Crisis Response Center of the Federal Foreign Office in Berlin. Since July 2013, he has served as the Consul General of Germany for Florida, Puerto Rico and the US Virgin Islands.
