

Mark Medish is CEO of The Messina Group International, a division of the strategic advisory firm led by former Obama campaign manager Jim Messina. Previously, Medish was president of Guggenheim International, LLC and a senior managing director of Guggenheim Partners, a financial services firm with \$220 billion assets under management. Medish was an equity partner at the international law firm of Akin, Gump, Strauss, Hauer & Feld, LLP and he was executive vice president of APCO Worldwide, the public affairs firm.

Medish served at The White House as Special Assistant to President Bill Clinton and Senior Director for Russian, Ukrainian and Eurasian Affairs on the National Security Council. He was Deputy Assistant Secretary for International Affairs at the U.S. Treasury. He also worked in senior posts at USAID and UNDP. He was vice president and senior scholar at the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace.

Medish was educated at Georgetown, Harvard University, Harvard Law School, and Oxford (Merton College). He was awarded Mellon, Luce, Fulbright, and Shintaro Abe scholarships.
