This course is designed for intermediate and advanced students of German who wish to extend their knowledge of the German language and culture, acquire proficiency with advanced grammatical structures, develop more sophisticated vocabulary and become confident and proficient writers in German.

The main course components include: reading and discussing various types of texts (literary and non-literary), refining written expression through different types of writing activities, and practicing grammar. Writing assignments will include practicing different genres such as portrait, description, parody, report, summary, critique/review, literary interpretation, argumentation, persuasion, etc. A variety of writing tasks, pre-writing strategies, and a mixture of individual, partner and group activities will help students develop their ideas as well as the language to support them. A good German English, English-German dictionary is required for this course.



The course will be conducted entirely in German. Prerequisite: successful completion of at least one intermediate level German course or approval from the instructor.
