This course is designed for intermediate level students of German. The students will view several acclaimed

contemporary German movies serving as a basis for discussion and German language acquisition. The class activities will include summary and interpretation of the movies, description of selected scenes, discussion of the cinematographic aspects

and the historical and socio-cultural background of the films, and finally exchanging personal cultural reflections. Each film viewing will be accompanied by pre-viewing and post-viewing activities that foster vocabulary enhancement and cultural awareness. A good German English, English-German dictionary is required for this course.
