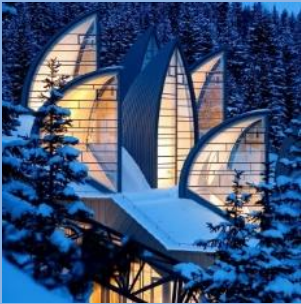

Intermediate German is a continuation of the first-year introductory German courses (German I and II). In this course, students will further develop their German language skills by discussing a variety of cultural topics and themes in the German-speaking world, including housing and living arrangements, banking and hotels, postal service, telephones and travel. Through extensive work on expanding vocabulary, reviewing major grammar topics, conversation and composition exercises, as well as group projects students will strengthen their spoken and written language skills and develop cultural competency. The course focuses on real communication in meaningful contexts.

The cultural focus of this course is Switzerland.

The course will be conducted in German. Prerequisite: completion of two semesters of German language instruction or permission of the instructor.

Students taking this course will receive credits towards the Undergraduate Certificate in German Language and Culture and the Certificate in European Studies
