Przemysław Stozek completed MA at the University of Warsaw (Polish Studies); MA at Theatre Academy in Warsaw (Theatre Studies) and PHD at the Institute of Art Polish Academy of Sciences (Modernist Studies). Currently is an Assistant Professor at the Institute of Art of the Polish Academy of Sciences in Warsaw, a lecturer at Academy of Fine Arts in Warsaw (Graphic Design Faculty), a lecturer at Collegium Civitas in Warsaw (Cultural Studies) and a 2012/2013 Fulbright Visiting Scholar at The University of Georgia (Modernist Studies). He is a member of European Network for Avantgarde and Modernist Studies and focuses his research on avant-garde and popular culture. He has authored several studies on Avant-garde, Polish modern and contemporary art and the relationships between soccer and visual culture. In 2013 he will be one of the speakers at the Football 150 Conference in the National Museum of Football in Manchester (UK), which celebrate the 150th anniversary of the founding of the Football Association.
