

The Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse Documentary

In line with all the great commemorative movies and television documentaries, comes this project for a full-length documentary entitled "Blasco Ibáñez and The Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse." Its goal is to offer insight into the personality of Blasco Ibáñez and the international success, over the past one hundred years, of his novel *The Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse* and of its movie adaptations. Ibáñez's novel narrates the story of Madariaga, a Spanish emigrant to Argentina, his daughters and his sons-in-law – one French and one German – and their return to Europe right before World War I breaks out. The plot is structured around two families – the Desnoyers and the Hartrott – that, despite being close relatives, take opposite sides in the conflict.

This screening is a collaboration of the Ruth K. and Shepard Broad Distinguished Lecture Series, European Studies Program, European Student Association, and the Council for Student Organizations.
