

Night Ride (Noćna vožnja): Film Screening & Conversation

WITH MEET EU FILMMAKER IN RESIDENCE VIDA SKERK

Join us for a private advanced screening of Night Ride (Noćna vožnja) and a conversation with the filmmaker. The film explores the identity crisis of a twenty-something student in Croatia. Dunja questions her decision to move to a bigger city and regrets leaving behind the safety of her hometown where she could always count on the support of her close friend, Sara. Exploring the boundaries of the film medium itself, Night Ride is constructed as a series of dreams and nightmares which evades a linear narrative structure and retains the qualities of a more stream-of-consciousness approach, presenting to the viewer Dunja's inner world in its most authentic, raw, and honest form.

Vida Skerk is a graduate student in the Film and TV Directing Program at the Academy of Dramatic Art, Zagreb, Croatia. Born in 1999 in Trieste, Italy, she is the author of a dozen short films, both documentaries and fiction, including Night Ride, Rosebud, and Hister, which have been screened at multiple festivals.
